



**BRIGHTSAND LAKE REGIONAL PARK AUTHORITY
BYLAW 2025-01**

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORGANIZATION

The Brightsand Lake Regional Park Authority in the Province of Saskatchewan pursuant to Section 13 of *The Regional Parks Act, 2013* enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This bylaw may be cited as the Emergency Management Organization (EMO) Bylaw.

GENERAL

2. Brightsand Lake Regional Park Authority shall establish a Local Emergency Management Organization to deal with any emergency or disaster that may occur.
3. Brightsand Lake Regional Park Authority shall appoint a person as a Local Emergency Coordinator.
4. Brightsand Lake Regional Park Authority shall establish a Local Emergency Planning Committee composed of:
 - a. The Local Emergency Coordinator, appointed in clause 2; and
 - b. Any other persons the Authority considers necessary.
5. The Local Emergency Coordinator is the Chairperson of the Local Emergency Planning Committee.
6. Brightsand Lake Regional Park Authority shall provide funding as deemed necessary and appropriate in the establishment and maintenance of the Emergency Management Organization.
7. This Bylaw shall come into full force and takes effect on the day of its final passing.
